

LANDSCAPE OF CONGRESSIONAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

The Alliance for Health Policy





Methods

From December 2023 through April 2024, the Alliance for Health Policy conducted 13 listening sessions with individuals, and in some cases, pairs of participants, to inform the development of a new educational program. During these sessions, multiple congressional learning opportunities were identified, and the Alliance recognized a need for a congressional learning opportunities repository that could be used by congressional staff for professional development. Some opportunities were identified through independent research from the Alliance staff. *The following is a working list of those opportunities, recognizing that many, but not all, opportunities that exist for congressional education are featured.*

This analysis includes several limitations. The chart does not reflect a comprehensive scan of all educational or professional development programs for congressional staff, just those that our participants identified listening tour participants and those which emerged during research.
